Racks must be removed when vehicle is put through an automatic car wash.







## **LADDER AND SAFETY NOTES**

## **BEFORE USE**



Inspect operation of ladder locks, rungs and telescopic parts before use each time. Do not use if damaged.




Remove any slippery contaminants from the ladder rungs such as mud, oil, grass or snow to ensure a secure grip.


## **LADDER AND TENT POSITIONING**




Inclination angle should not exceed 75 degrees.



Ladder should be positioned on an even, level and unmovable surface.




Position ladder away from high traffic areas as ladder positioning may be disturbed and may risk security of positioning.




Be mindful of the terrain you choose to park on. An inclined ground will mean an inclined sleep.


## **LADDER AUTOMATIC LOCKS:**

The PUSH locks found on both ends of each ladder rungs. When both PUSH locks are pressed simultaneously, the side rail and rungs above the lock collapses inside the telescopic rail. To lengthen and lock the ladder in position, extend the ladder rung and side rail and the lock 'clicks' automatically.




## **RETRACTING THE LADDER:**

When both SLIDE locks are slid simultaneously, the side rail and rungs above the lock collapses inside the telescopic rail. To lengthen and lock the ladder in position, extend the ladder rung and side rail and the lock 'clicks' automatically.

## **Roof Rack Carrying Capacity**

Check your vehicle owners hand book for vehicle maximum carrying capacity.

Please ensure you use the vehicle manufacturer's maximum roof allowance if it is lower than the figure listed in this instruction.

**IMPORTANT:** 

Ensure your vehicle roof has a load rating higher than the weight of both the tent and any mounted accessories, and a static load limit that can support the tent in use.



Tent Weight Capacity = 300kg / 661bs

## Warning

- Do not attempt to fit the accessory to your vehicle unless you fully understand these fitting instructions. Please direct any questions regarding fitting to the dealer from where the product was purchased.
- Off-road conditions can be much more rigorous. Extreme care must be taken in off road conditions.
- Rooftop Tent and Roof Rack System must be removed when vehicle is put through an automatic car wash.
- Ensure product is locked before driving.

#### In service maintenance checks

- All bolt connections should be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your roof racks.
- All bolted connections should be checked again at regular intervals (weekly is recommended, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled).
- All bolted connections should be checked each time they are re-fitted.
- Off-road conditions are more rigorous. Check all bolted connections and your load more regularly.
- Ensure that your vehicle manufacturer's GVM, and gross axle weights are not exceeded (refer to vehicle owner's manual).

#### Sensitivity to Crosswinds, Behaviour in Curves and Braking.

Remember that the handling characteristics of your vehicle will change when transporting a load on the roof. Exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resisting loads; special consideration must be taken into account when braking.

T3 - 2 x Step Ladders


**T4** - USB-A Powerbank (Optional for included LED light bar)

T5 - x2 Large Towels / Table cloth (If underbars need to be repositioned)




Tent underbars (S) must be oriented correctly according to your roof rack system. Refer to the SET UPS below to determine your required underbar mounting orientation.

## TENT USAGE: LED LIGHT BAR










- Make sure there are no sharp items left in the tent.
- Allow tent to dry completely before stowing, otherwise wipe dry asap.
- Close the zippers of the doors and windows most of the way, **leaving them slightly open** to allow the tent to air out while it is folded.


NOTE: For ease of future setup, bedding can be left inside. Ensure tent is still able to close fully














